Fresh breeze from S.W. and quiet pleasant in the first of the day middle and latter part the wind hauled to S. and blowed strong the Barque has been with all sails out in the first but when began to breeze strong we took in sail steering W.N.W. and N.N.W. in the latter part

Thursday Oct. 23^d

Strong breeze from W.S.W. in the first of the day in the latter part moderate the Barque under easy sails heading to S.W.

Friday Oct. 24th

Strong breeze from W. and rugged in the first part the Barque under all sails cruising in the latter part moderate and quiet clear the water green but no whales

Saturday Oct. 25th

Fresh breeze from W. to N.W. all day the Barque under all sails cruising the weather quiet cloudy

Sunday Oct. 26th

Fine breeze and pleasant all this day the Barque cruising under all sails

Monday Oct. 27th

Light breeze from S. in the first of the day and very pleasant in the latter part the wind hauled to E.S.E. the Barque head to the S. we saw many feen Backs and feed Lat. 35-26
