Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan of New Bedford

Tuesday Oct. 28th

Light breeze from N.E. and fine sea
 then the Barque made sail and steered
 S. by W. with all sails out
 Lat. 35=50 Long. 176=18 W.

Wednesday Oct. 29th

Light breeze from N.E. and pleasant
 in the first of the day in the latter
 part cloudy and wind shifted to
 N.N.E. and still smooth
 Lat. 36=43 Long. 170=50

Thursday Oct. 30th

Fresh breeze from N.E. and hauling
 to S.N.E. the Barque cruising with
 all sails out till the day we spoke
 Adeline gibbs and gained

Friday Oct. 31st

Light and moderate breeze from N.E.
 and foggy in the first part of the day
 but in the latter part quiet clear we
 spoke gibbs and gained all day

Saturday Nov. 1st

Light breeze from N.E. and foggy in
 the first of the day middle part clear
 in the latter fog again the gibbs in
 sight all day

Sunday Nov. 2^d

Fresh breeze from N.E. all this day and rain
 the Barque under short sails

Monday Nov. 3^d

This day begins with calm and thick fog
 all the first part in the latter part
 we got breeze from S.S.W. and we steered
 N.E. by E.

Tuesday Nov. 4th

Strong breeze from S.S.W. in the first of the
 day the steering N.E. by in the latter part
 quiet squally we steered E.N.E. the wind
 still stronger and more rugged

Wednesday Nov. 5th

Strong breeze from S. in the first of the day
 made sail and steering E.N.E. and then
 we change our course to N.N.W. and
 then S.S.E. over hauling blocks

Thursday Nov. 6th

Light breeze from S. and smooth all
 day the Barque under all sails cruising

Friday Nov. 7th

The first part of this day begins with
 calm at 8 A.M. Saw two whales we
 lamer four boats and chase but no
 chance and then on coming aboard
 the ship saw two more whales third
 mate went on and lay knock and
 lost the breeze from N.E. the whales
 going to Easter quiet fast the whales
 raised by Luis got boat stowed and
 we over hauled wheel blocks

Lat. 36=40 W

Saturday Nov. 8th

Fresh breeze from N.E. in the first part
 of this day the Barque under all sails but
 in the latter part strong breeze at 130
 P.M. we saw whales we lamer 4
 boats weist boat thated but did not
 fasten whales raised by Luis

Sunday Nov. 9th

Strong breeze from N.E. and squally
 in the first part of the day in the
 latter part calm and then light air
 from N.W.
