Remarks on Board Barge C. W. Morgan of New Bedford

Monday Nov. 24th

Light breeze from N.N.W. and pleasant all day the Barge steering S.S.W. with all sails

Tuesday Nov. 25th

This day begins with light breeze from N.N.E. in the first part of the day in the latter part fresh breeze from N. and Barge steered S. with main top gallant sail out

Wednesday Nov. 26th

This day begins with fresh breeze from S. and cloudy weather in the first of the day in the latter part rainy and the wind N.N.W. the Barge had steered S. all day at sundown took in sail and lay to heading W. Lat. 44-36 South

Thursday Nov. 27th

Fresh breeze from W. in the first part of the day the heading to S.S.W. in the latter pleasant and light breeze we wore round and steered N.E. the wind about the same

Friday Nov. 28th

This day begins light breeze from N.W. the Barge steering N.E. by N. middle and latter part fresh breeze from N.W. and quiet foggy by times the Barge steering about the same

Saturday Nov. 29th

Light breeze from W. in the first of the day the Barge steering N.N.E. in the latter part the wind variable and rainy at 4 P.M. took in sail the breeze quiet fresh

Sunday Nov. 30th

This day begins with fresh breeze from W.S.W. and Barge steering N.W. middle and latter part strong breeze and hauling to N.W. and generally

Strong breeze from S.W. to W. and squally all day the Barge jib and spenker two lower top sails and fore sail heading from W. N.W. to N.N.E.

Tuesday Dec. 2nd

Strong breeze from S.W. to W. and heavy sea all day the weather very rugged Barge heading from N.W. to N. under easy sails Lat. 40-31 South

Wednesday Dec. 3rd

Gale from S.W. all this day the Barge under bare pole

Thursday Dec. 4th

Fresh breeze from S.W. in the first part of the day but in the latter part light breeze the wind hauled to W. and we came to m and so end this day

Friday Dec. 5th

This day begins with fresh breeze from N. and then became thick and rainy the Barge steered W. with whole top sails middle part blown strong we took in sail in the latter part the wind hauled to W. and Barge head off to S. at 5:30 P.M. wore ship and head to N.N.W.

Saturday Dec. 6th

This day begins with fresh breeze from W. & quiet clear middle and latter thick but hauling to W.N.W. the Barge heading about S.W.

Sunday Dec. 7th

Fresh breeze from W.S.W. all day and quiet & sweet the Barge heading about S.W. by the wind under whole top sails
