Monday Dec. 8<sup>th</sup>  
Light breeze from W.N.W. and thick fog in the first of the day, middle part clear in the latter part became calm and rainy and heavy swell from S.W.

Tuesday Dec. 9<sup>th</sup>  
This day begins with light breeze from W. and pleasant we steered S. but in the latter became squally and rain at 5:30 we took in all sails but main lower top sail and steered S.E.

Wednesday Dec. 10<sup>th</sup>  
This day begins with fresh breeze from W.S.W. the Barque steering S.S.E. middle and latter part strong breeze from S.W. and squally at 3:45 P.M. took in to lower top sail.

Thursday Dec. 11<sup>th</sup>  
Fresh breeze from S.W. in the first part of the day at 9 A.M. saw upates we lower three boats B.B. struck took him long side at 2 P.M. and cut him in the whales raised by Diago

Friday Dec. 12<sup>th</sup>  
This day begins with light wind and rainy the variable middle part quiet in the latter part rainy and foggy the Barque under short sails and boiling

Saturday Dec. 13<sup>th</sup>  
Strong wind and squally weather all this day the wind hauling one way and nother about all the times and we are still Boiling

Sunday Dec. 14<sup>th</sup>  
Heavy Gale from W. and S.W. all day with small squalls ship under bare pole

Monday Dec. 15<sup>th</sup>  
Strong breeze and squally from W.S.W. in the first part of the day in the latter part more moderate we stowed down our oil

Tuesday Dec. 16<sup>th</sup>  
Strong breeze from S.E. in the first of day middle and latter part quiet moderate and hauled to S. the Barque heading about W.S.W.

Wednesday Dec. 17<sup>th</sup>  
This day begins with strong breeze from S. in the first part of the day middle and latter part pleasant the wind hauled S.S.E. the Bark under whole top sails and courses

Thursday Dec. 18<sup>th</sup>  
This day begins with calm in the first of the day middle and latter part light breeze from S.E. and hauling to N. and N. by W. we steered E. by N.

Friday Dec. 19<sup>th</sup>  
This day begins with light breeze from N.N.W. and cloudy middle and latter part clear the cruising of the Barque is quiet dry at this time at sun down took in sail and still steering to south under easy sails

Saturday Dec. 20<sup>th</sup>  
Fresh breeze from N. in the first part of the day the steered S.S.E. in the latter part became foggy rainy at 6 P.M. we took in sails at 9 P.M. wore ship and head W.S.W. the wind about N.W.

Sunday Dec. 21<sup>st</sup>  
Light breeze from W.S.W. all day and part foggy the wind hauled to S.W. Lat. 45-47 Long. 155-28 W.

Monday Dec. 22<sup>nd</sup>  
Light breeze from S.W. and light rain in the first of the day middle and latter part pleasant
