Tuesday Dec. 23^d

Light breeze from S.E. and Pleasant in the first of the day in the latter part the same the Barque steered S.W. by W. all sails out

Wednesday Dec. 24th

Light breeze and variable all day the Barque steering to from S.W. to W.S.W. with main gotten

Thursday Dec. 25th

Light wind and variable with very Pleasant weather the Barque working to westward

Friday Dec. 26th

Light and variable wind in the first of the day in the latter part rainy and calm

Saturday Dec. 27th

This day begins with calm and light Rain squalls middle and latter part Pleasant

Sunday Dec. 28th

Light breeze from N.W. and pleasant all day at 6 P.M. saw eight whale lower no chance Lat. 46° 10'

Monday Dec. 29th

Strong breeze from N.W. and rainy thick fog all day the Barque under easy sails

Tuesday Dec. 30th

Strong breeze from S.W. in the first of the day at 6 P.M. saw whale we lower three boats but no chance in the latter part Calm at 5 P.M. got breeze from S.E.

Wednesday Dec. 31st

Strong breeze from S.E. in the first of the day and cloudy middle part Calm we saw whale we lower Boats but no chance in the latter light breeze from S.E. to N. and rain

Friday Jan. 2^d

Strong breeze from S. and squally we made sail and steered W. under easy sail in the latter part quiet moderate Lat. 45° 25'

Saturday Jan. 3^d

This day begins with Light breeze from S.W. middle and latter part Calm but at 6 P.M. got light air from N. the Barque steered S.W. by W. under easy sails

Sunday Jan. 4th

This day begins with fresh breeze from N. the Barque steering W.S.W. the wind begins to haul to E. and raining and then to S.E. and blowed gale

Monday Jan. 5th

Heavy Gale from S.W. and rainy all this day the Barque under bare Poole lying to

Tuesday Jan. 6th

Strong breeze from S.W. and squally all this day the Barque under easy sails heaving about N.W. and N.W. by W.

Wednesday Jan. 7th

The first part of this day strong breeze from W.S.W. and then become strong heavy squalls but middle and latter part moderate and clear the Barque under easy sails heading to N. and then wind haul to S. the Barque heading to W. by S.
