Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan of New Bedford

Tuesday Jan. 20th

This day begins with light breeze from S.E. and the Barque working for the Bay waitange but the wind being head we left for cruise and steered N.W. in the latter part saw one whaler and named her the Othello of New Zealand

Wednesday Jan. 21st

This begins with fine weather light breeze from N.W. and backing to N.E. at 9:30 A.M. we saw whales lacer four Boats W.B. Struck and lost raised by Luis the Barque are in sight

Thursday Jan. 22^d

Fresh breeze from N.W. and rainy in the first part of the day and then wind hauled to W. and S.W. Blowed heavy we lacer way lower fore top sail in the latter part more moderate we same sail and steered N.W. by W.

Friday Jan. 23^d

Moderate breeze from S.W. and pleasant in the first of the day middle part calm at 7 P.M. saw whales we lower four Boats but no chance whales going very fast we left and came aboard in the latter breeze from N. the whales heading N.N.W.

Saturday Jan. 24th

Fresh breeze from W. by N. in the first of the day middle part light breeze in the latter part the same but variable and we are repairing fore lower top sail

Sunday Jan. 25th

Light breeze and pleasant all this day the Barque under all sails the wind variable hauling from W. to N.N.W.

Monday Jan. 26th

Fresh breeze and variable in the first part of the day but in the latter part calm the Barque under all sails we repairing fore top sail

Tuesday Jan. 27th

Light breeze from W. in the first part of the day in the latter part the wind hauled to N.W. the Barque under all sails got true repairing fore top sail

Wednesday Jan. 28th

Strong breeze from W. in the first part of the middle part calm but in the latter part little breeze from S. the Barque steered N.W. by N. at sun down the weather look cloudy

Thursday Jan. 29th

This day begins with strong breeze from E. S.E. and rainy the Barque steering N. by W. middle and latter part the wind hauled to E.N.E. and the weather overcast the steering the same

Friday Jan. 30th

Strong breeze from N.E. and rainy in the first of the day the Barque steering N. by W. we saw a vessel heading to S.E. middle part calm in the latter part light air and variable

Saturday Jan. 31st

Light and variable wind all this day very Pleasant the Barque heading to N. with sails out

Sunday Feb. 1st

Light breeze from W. by S. in the first of the day the Barque steering N.N.W. saw one vessel heading to S.E. and rated mizzin guller top mast riggin in the latter part very fine weather and warm shorten sails small watch
