

Remarks on Board Barge C. W. Morgan of New Bedford

Monday Feb. 2^d

Light breeze from W.S.W. and Pleasant in the first of the day the Barge steering N.N.W. we Cleared our Bore and repaired mizzen top mast rigging in the latter part. Calm

Tuesday Feb. 3^d

Light breeze from N.E. to N.N.E. all this day the Barge under all sails heading to N.W. we wash Bore

Wednesday Feb. 4th

Light breeze from N.N.E. all this and cloudy the Barge heading to N.W. with all sails out the weather Drizzling

Thursday Feb. 5th

Fresh breeze from N.E. and rainy in the first of the day middle and latter the same rain and strong breeze from E.S.E. at sundown the Barge heading about N.

Friday Feb. 6th

Strong breeze from E. to E.S.E. all this day and rugged the Barge steered N.N.W. and Courses and jib the weather very Squally

Saturday Feb. 7th

Strong breeze from S.E. in the first of the day in the latter part moderate the Barge steered N.N.E. under Courses & whole main top sail

Sunday Feb. 8th

Strong breeze from S.E. in the first part of the day the Barge heading to N.E. saw two vessels Barge and a Steamer in the latter part moderate and the wind hauled to E.

Monday Feb. 9th

The first part of the day Strong breeze from E.S.E. in the latter part from E. and rugged the Barge under easy sails heading about N.N.E.

Tuesday Feb. 10th

Strong breeze from S.E. in the first of the day in the latter part Squally the wind about E. the Barge under easy sails heading about N.N.E.

Wednesday Feb. 11th

Fresh breeze from S.E. in the first of the day middle and latter part quiet pleasant & clear and wind hauling to E. we banded our Bore

Thursday Feb. 12th

Light breeze from E.S.E. and pleasant all day the Barge under all sails but at sundown we took in light sails

Friday Feb. 13th

Light breeze from E.S.E. all day and very pleasant the Barge under all sails cruising

Saturday Feb. 14th

Light breeze from S.E. to E.S.E. in the first part of the day but in the latter part fresh breeze and cloudy took in light sails at 1 P.M.

Sunday Feb. 15th

This day begins with light breeze from S.E. and smooth the Barge heading to S. but middle and latter part strong breeze and rugged

Monday Feb. 16th

Strong breeze from E. and rugged all this day the Barge heading to S. and S. by E. under top sails and Courses jib and Spinnaker
