Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan of New

Tuesday Feb. 17th

Strong breeze from E.S.E. and rugged in the first part of the day middle and latter very squally we took in upon top sails the Barque heading to S.

Wednesday Feb. 18th

Fresh breeze from E. all day and clear the Barque Steered S. by E. under easy sails at is top sails and Courses

Thursday Feb. 19th

Strong breeze from E. in the first of the day at 10 A.M. we Cape off and Steered S.W. in the latter part the same but at Sun down took in sails still running

Friday Feb. 20th

Strong breeze from E. in the first of the day the Barque Steering S.W. in the latter part moderate and pleasant Steered W by S. and W.S.W.

Saturday Feb. 21st

Light breeze from S.E. in the first of the day the Barque Steering S.W. by W. made all sails and Steered the same all day at night shorten sail

Sunday Feb. 22^d

Light breeze from S. to S.W. and pleasant all day the Barque under all sail but fore top gallant sail

Monday Feb. 23^d

Light breeze from S.W. in the first of the day the Barque heading S.E. we saw the Island three Kings in the latter part light breeze from S.S.W. at 5 P.M. three Kings bore S.E. 5 miles off

Tuesday Feb. 24th

Light breeze from S. to S.E. and pleasant all day the Barque Cruising to the North of the Island three Kings but land in sight at Sundown three Kings 40 miles South

Wednesday Feb. 25th

Light breeze from S. to S.E. in the first of the day the Islands in sight but in the latter part fresh breeze but pleasant

Thursday Feb. 26th

Fresh breeze from S. all this day, and clear the wind is quiet cool but the weather pleasant at Sun down took sails heading E.

Friday Feb. 27th

Light breeze from S. to S.E. in the first of the day in the latter part quiet calm light air from S.S.W.

Saturday Feb. 28th

This day commences with middle part light air from N.E. in the latter heavy rain & thunder and lightning the wind variable but very light

Sunday March 1st

Light breeze from E. and pleasant all day we made sail and Steered N.W. by W. all day at Sun down change course to W. by N.

Monday March 2^d

Light breeze from N.E. in the first part of the day in the latter part the wind hauling to E. but weather very pleasant but there are some rain squalls round off in distance we Steered about W. by E. all day at Sun down took in sails
