Light breeze from W.S.W. and pleasant in the first of the day in the latter cloudy and fine rain by times

Sunday March 8th

Light breeze from N. in the first of the day middle part rainy but in the latter part quiet pleasant and the wind hauled to W.

Monday March 9th

Fresh breeze from S.W. in the first of the day in the latter part the wind about S. the Barge heading W. to W.S.W. at 5.45 we saw Spouts we suppose to be Spout whale but we not sure by Diego
