Monday April 13th

Strong breeze from E. and rugged all day the Barge under two lower top sails in the latter part the same and hauling more to E.N.E.

Tuesday April 14th

Strong breeze from E.N.E. all this day and Squally the Barge under two lower top sails and fore and main stay sail

Wednesday April 15th

Strong breeze from N.E. and rugged in the first of the day in the latter part the same and the wind hauled again to E.N.E.

Thursday April 16th

Strong breeze from E. and rugged all day the Barge under easy sails

Friday April 17th

Strong breeze from E.S.E. and Squally all the day the Barge under easy sails heading to E.N.E.

Saturday April 18th

This day begins with light breeze from S. and then become calm in the latter part light air from N.E. and rain at sun down and lightning

Sunday April 19th

Light breeze from N.W. and pleasant in first part of the day in the latter part Squally and we have steered E. all day & took in sails at sundown

Monday April 20th

The first part of this day light air from E. in the latter breeze from N. we steered E.

Fresh breeze from N. and pleasant in the first of the day but in the latter part Squally we steered E. all day with all sails out at sun down the wind N.W. Lat. 32-52 South

Wednesday April 22^d

Strong breeze from W.S.W. in the first of the day in the latter Squally and the wind hauling S.W. and S. the Barge steered to E. and E.N.E. under easy sails

Lat. about 33-30 Long. 177-00

Thursday April 23^d

Light breeze from S.E. in the first of this day the Barge steered N.E. in the latter part pleasant and the wind hauled to S.S.W. at sundown took in and bye to

Friday April 24th

This day begins with calm we broke out some sail and cooper them and stowed down again all hands employed in the work all day in the latter part the same calm

Saturday April 25th

The first part of this day begins with calm middle and latter part light air from E. and hauling to E.N.E. the Barge steered S. with all sails out at sundown took in sails

Sunday April 26th

This day commences with in the first of the middle and latter part light and variable wind with rain Squally

Monday April 27th

Calm in the first part of this day and pleasant in the latter part the same smooth all day and clear weather
