Tuesday April 28th

This day begins with light breeze from N. and the Barque steering S. S. W. middle and latter part fresh breeze from the same the weather pleasant

Wednesday April 29th

This day commences with strong winds and heavy rain storm the Barque steering S. S. W. at 7 A.M. the wind hauled to W. and still strong the made some sail in the latter part more moderate the Barque steering by the wind heading about S. W. by S. bled in Port
Lat. 34-22 Long. 176-32

Thursday April 30th

This day begins with calm in the first part middle part fresh breeze from N. and rainy in the latter part clear and light breeze the Barque steering about W.

Friday May 1st

Light and variable wind in the first part of the day in the latter part strong breeze and squally rain we saw land at 11 A.M. we steered for it but became thick and the wind hauled to S. we hauled to E. S. E. and took up top sail

Saturday May 2nd

This day begins with moderate gale from S. W. and rainy in the first of the day middle and latter part clear but still blowing strong the Barque lying to with lower main top sail no land in sight to day

Sunday May 3rd

Moderate gale from S. the Barque under easy sails heading to westward in the first part of the day in the latter part head to E. S. E. some whaler in sight the Barque Triton

Monday May 4th

Strong breeze from S. and rugged in the first part of the day in the latter part the wind hauled to S. W. and still blowing strong the under lower top sails heading to S. E. one sail in sight

Tuesday May 5th

Strong breeze from S. W. in the first part of the day and very rugged in the latter part more moderate and the wind hauled to S. at 3 30 P.M. we wore ship and head to westward Lat. 34-22 Long. 178

Wednesday May 6th

Fresh breeze from S. to S. W. and W. S. W. all day the Barque working to S. and E. at 4 P.M. took in light sails

Thursday May 7th

Strong breeze from W. and squally in the first part of the day in the latter part the wind hauled to S. W. the Barque under easy sails heading to S. S. E.

Friday May 8th

Light breeze from W. S. W. and cloudy weather in the first of the day in the latter part calm Lat. 35-11 Long. 178-11 E.

Saturday May 9th

Light breeze from N. in the first part middle and latter part strong strong breeze and squally
