This commences with fresh breeze from N.W. in the first of the day but in the latter part quiet pleasant and smooth the wind about W.

Tuesday May 26thTook

Strong breeze from N.W. to S.W. the Barge to anchor at Mongoni this day we took Boom on board

Wednesday May 27thPut out
jib
Boom

To anchor at Mongoni this day we have very fine weather we put out jib boom and commence setting up rigging

All this day we had fresh breeze from S.W. and quiet Pleasant we finish our jib boom and Bent the sails the Steamer came in the same day in the morning and we had a good time our Mate got Married and the Schooner came in to the Mongoni at the Murreage we fired 20 shells guns and Blowed horns

Friday May 29th

This day we have a fine weather and pleasant we repaired lower main top sail and painted chains getting ready for sea

Saturday May 30th

To anchor at Mongoni this day we had very fine weather the work is not very much at present

Sunday May 31st

All this day we had a fine day and pleasant I took Rick to Rally for a good time with friends and came Back at 8:30 P.M.

Fine weather all this day we repaired upper main top sail to anchor at Mongoni

Tuesday June 2nd

To anchor at Mongoni this day we have very fine weather and the wind S. but quiet cold

Wednesday June 3rdTook

To anchor at Mongoni this day with very fine weather we took in our Provision 30 Barrels flour 2000 Pound Bread molasses and 1 Cask Beef

Thursday June 4th

This day commences with little rain and wind from E. in the first part of the day in the latter part very Pleasant the crew employed in Stowing Provision

Friday June 5th

To anchor at Mongoni with very fine weather this day we broke some oil to sell about 3 Casks 923 gallons of oil

Saturday June 6thThe mate
off to rally

This begins with fine rain in the first of the day in the latter part quiet pleasant the First Mate and fourth mate went out to rally for a ride left the ship at 10:30 A.M. at 4:30 P.M. the Squaw came in we hoed and sided the anchor and found it clear we let go again

Sunday June 7th

This day begins with fresh breeze from N. but in the latter part strong and S. greatly the Barge to anchor at Mongoni
