Sunday July 19<sup>th</sup>Strong  
easterly  
wind

Strong breeze from E. and squally all this day and very rugged the Bark steered about N. with whole top sails at 7 P.M. we wore round took in to lower top sails S.E.

Monday July 20<sup>th</sup>Strong  
winds

Strong breeze from E. and rugged all this day we made some sail and steered by the wind heading about N. with lower top sails and courses

Tuesday July 21<sup>st</sup>

Strong breeze from N.E. and heavy swell in the first part of the day in the latter part moderate the Barge steering by the wind heading about N.N.W. with whole top sails and courses jib and spanker

Wednesday July 22<sup>d</sup>

Light breeze from N.N.E. and pleasant the Barge steering by the wind heading about N.W. in the latter part we wore ship and head to eastward wind very light but little swell on from N.E.

This day commences with fresh breeze from S.E. and rainy the Barge steering N.W. in the latter part very strong wind & rugged

Strong breeze from S.E. in the first of the day we lower boat and shore trading in the latter part rainy and became calm at 5 P.M. breeze on again and Boat came on Board at 630 P.M.

Monday July 27<sup>th</sup>

Strong breeze from S.E. in the first of the day but in the latter part more moderate we lower Boat and try to get men but no chance

Light breeze from S.E. in the first of the day in the latter part the same the wind about E. we lower boat and mate went on shore but he did not get any thing

Wednesday July 29<sup>th</sup>

Light breeze from E. in the first of this day in the latter the same we lower Boat and Captain went on shore but he could not get men

Light breeze from S.E. and Barge heading N.N.E. with all sails out the Island in sight in the first part but in the latter part rainy and clouds no land in sight
