Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan of New

Friday July 31st

Light breeze from S.E. in the first of the day the Barque heading to N.E. by E. to S.N.E. with all sails out in the latter part light rain but the wind very moderate and smooth at 130 P.M. we raised the Island at 5 P.M. we took ship heading to S.E.W.

Saturday August 1st

Light breeze from S.E. and Barque heading S.E. in the first part of the day we took ship and head for the Island we saw a Schooner and about come from shore to our Barque thinking that we want to go in

Sunday August 2^d

This day begins with fine breeze and pleasant at 7.45 A.M. we lowered boat and Captain and his wife went on shore and came back at 6 P.M. and then sent boat in again and got four men the Boat got back at 11 P.M.

Monday August 3^d

This day begins with calm and the Island in sight in the latter fine breeze from E. hauling to S.E.E.

Tuesday August 4th

This day begins with fresh breeze from S.E. in the first part of the day in the latter part we took ship and hauled to E. and commenced to rain

Wednesday August 5th

Fresh breeze from E. and the Barque steering by the wind heading about S.E.E. to S. all day

Thursday August 6th

Light breeze from E. and Barque steering S.E.E. saw a small Island in the latter part pleasant

Strong breeze from E. and rugged the Barque steering S.E. in the first of the day in the latter part more moderate steered S by E. 1/4 E.

Saturday August 8th

This day commences with light breeze from N. but middle part calm in the latter part breeze from S.E. the Barque steered W.S. with all sails out Lat. 18=50 South

Sunday August 9th

This day begins with fresh breeze from S. and hauling to S.E. in the latter part wind light variable but little rain by times we saw Scholl black fish

Monday August 10th

This day begins with light breeze from S. S.W. we made sails and heading about W. at 7 A.M. wore round heading to S.E. saw french steamer and Th. Back gave fore and main top sails braces & main braces all so

Tuesday August 11th

Light breeze from S.E. and pleasant in the first of the day at 10 A.M. saw land and we saw school sperm whales lower four Boats West Boat went on and made another bad work Boats came aboard at 3 P.M. the steering by the wind heading about S. by W. and we took fourth mate for Boat Steve

Wednesday August 12th

Fine weather and pleasant all day we painted all four Boats and saw one Island the wind from S.E. to E. saw a steamer
