

Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan of New Bedford C. F. Keith Master on the whaling voyage

Thursday August 13th

Light breeze from S.E. in the first of the day the Barque steering S.E. but fine rain by times middle part calm in the latter part light breeze from N.

Friday August 14th

Light breeze from N. all this day the Bark steering S.E. under easy sails at Sun down commence to rain

Saturday August 15th

Strong breeze from S. and rugged all this day the Barque under whole top sails in the first part in the latter part down to lower top sail jib & Spiker at Sun down look in sails the Barque heading about W.S.W.

Sunday August 16th

Strong breeze from S. in the first of the day in the latter part the hauled to E.S.E.

Monday August 17th

Fresh breeze from S.E. and cloudy weather all day the steering by the wind heading about S.S.W.

Tuesday August 18th

This day begins with fresh breeze from E. in the first of the day in the latter part the same and more cloudy the Barque under easy sails

Wednesday August 19th

Strong breeze from S.E. and rainy in the first of the day the Barque made short & steered S.W. in the latter part more moderate and wind hauled E.S.E. at Sun down took in sails

Thursday August 20th

Strong breeze from S.E. and rugged all day the Bark under easy sails

Friday August 21st

Strong breeze from S.E. in the first of the day in the latter the wind from S.E. and squally the Barque heading to S.N.E. steering by the wind under easy sails

Saturday August 22nd

Strong breeze from S. in the first part and squally in the latter part blowed heavy the Barque under two lower top sails

Sunday August 23rd

This day begins with moderate gale from S.E. and hauling to E.S.E. in the first part of the day in the latter part the same our mate has been sick to day of head ache

Monday August 24th

Light breeze from E. and cloudy weather in the first part of the day in the latter part pleasant and clear the wind E.S.E.

Tuesday August 25th

Light and variable wind with light rain & squalls in the first of the day but in the latter part fine breeze from N. and pleasant the Barque heading to eastward

Wednesday August 26th

Fresh breeze and variable all day the Barque under all sails steered to S.E. rain squalls once or while but quiet smooth Lat. 26-47 South

Thursday August 27th

Strong breeze from S.E. and squally in the first part of the day in the latter part quiet pleasant but cloudy saw number four Backs

Friday August 28th

Fresh breeze from S.E. in the first of the day in the latter part the wind from S. and pleasant
