Saturday August 29th
This begins with fresh breeze from S.E. and squalls by times but in the latter part fresh breeze and clear the Barque under whole top sails

Sunday August 30th
Strong breeze from S.E. and rugged in the first part of the day in the latter part the same at 11 A.M. took in top sails

Monday August 31st
Light breeze E.S.E. in the first of the day middle and latter part Calm and light air the Barque under all sails

Tuesday September 1st
This day begins with Calm and very smooth in the first of the day middle and latter part fine breeze from N.N.W. and pleasant the Barque steered S. by E. Lat. 27-26

Wednesday Sept. 2^d
Strong breeze from N.N.W. in the first of the day the Barque steering S. by E. middle part become squally and blowing heavy took in sail and wind hauled to W.S.W. in the latter part moderate

Thursday Sept. 3^d
Fresh breeze from S.W. in the first of the day middle and latter part quiet moderate and pleasant the Island closed by

Friday Sept. 4th
This day begins with Calm and then light breeze from S. in the latter part fresh breeze from W. and cloudy the Barque heading to S.E. the Island has been in sight all day and we saw plenty fire birds

Strong breeze from S.E.W. and rugged in the first of the day the Barque under easy sails heading to S.E. in the latter part moderate

Sunday Sept. 6th
Fresh breeze from S.W. in the first of the day middle and latter part the same but very clear and wind hauling to W.S.W.

Monday Sept. 7th
The first part of this day fresh breeze from W. to W.N.W. the Barque steering S. by W. with whole top sails and courses but in the latter part squally and hauling to S.

Tuesday Sept. 8th
Light breeze from S. in the first part middle part breeze hauled to S.W. in the latter part the wind about W.S.W. the weather cloudy and cold

Wednesday Sept. 9th
Clear in sun this day strong breeze from S.W. and squally the Barque under easy sails in the latter part gale from S.W. took in all sails Lat. 35-08 N.

Thursday Sept. 10th
Strong winds and very squally weather all day in the morning we made a little sail but took it in again the weather being so bad

Friday Sept. 11th
The first part of this day blowing heavy but in the latter part more moderate the wind from S. has been bout all day

Moderate gale from S. all day the Barque under lower main top sail and fore top mast stay sail
