Lat. 34-01 South

Monday Sept. 14th

Light and variable wind and light rain
squalls about all day the Barque under
bare whole tops and courses

Tuesday Sept. 15th

Light breeze from S. to S.S.E. about all
day and very pleasant the Barque under
all sails heading to eastward

Wednesday Sept. 16th

Light breeze from W.N.W. in the first of
the day and pleasant the Barque steered
S. in the latter part cloudy and became
rainy we took in some sails at sun
down the wind about W.

Thursday Sept. 17th

This day begins with fine breeze from S. and
pleasant the Barque heading to E.S.E. in
the latter part the wind hauled to W.N.W.
we steered S. by W.

Friday Sept. 18th

Strong breeze from S.W. and clear all
day the Barque heading to S.S.E. under
whole top sails and courses

Saturday Sept. 19th

Fresh breeze from S. in the first of the day
middle part squally but in the latter part
pleasant the Barque under whole top sails

Sunday Sept. 20th

Light breeze from S.E. in the first of the
day in the latter part calm and pleasant

the first of the day in the latter part the same
the Barque under easy sails heading to westward

Wednesday Sept. 23rd

Light breeze from S.S.E. in the first of the
day middle and latter part calm saw Pl
nky fin backs

Thursday Sept. 24th

This day begins with light air from S.S.E.
in the first of the day middle and latter part
calm but the weather very smooth at sundown
light breeze from S.S.W. Barque heading S.E.

Friday Sept. 25th

Strong breeze from S. and squally weather in
the first part of the day middle and latter
part the same but clear Barque under easy
sails heading E.S.E. we were round and head
W.S.W.

Saturday Sept. 26th

Light breeze from S. in the first of the day
in the latter part calm and very smooth

Sunday Sept. 27th

Strong breeze from W.N.W. and Barque steering
S. in the first of the day at M. we took in
sails and came to by the wind heading a
bout N.E. the weather quiet thick and rainy

water 12+2 Monday Sept. 28th

Strong breeze from W.N.W. we made sail and
steered S.S.W. made land and we came to
anchor at 9:30 P.M. at Chukam island
