Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan of New Bedford

Tuesday Sept. 29th

To anchor at Chatham

This day begins with fresh breeze from W.N.W. the Barque to anchor at Chatham getting wood and Potatoes in the latter part rainy & thick weather the wind about the same

Wednesday Sept. 30th

Left Chatham for cruise

Is anchor at Chatham Island in the first part of the day rainy and foggy but the weather very smooth we got off wood & Potatoes in the latter part the wind got out about W. and hauling to N.W. we got under away and Steered N.N.E. with all sails out

Thursday October 1st

Plenty Birds

This begins with strong breeze from W.N.W. in the latter part moderate the Barque Steered N.E. by N. with all sails out at Sun down be come calm

Friday Oct. 2^d

Landed jib away

This day begins with strong breeze from N.N.W. and rainy the Barque heading S.E. by E. at 9 A.M. crewed away Band from jib boom and stays we took in all sails and come to in the latter blowed gale from N.W.

Saturday Oct. 3^d

Strong breeze and squally in the first of the day we made sail and Steered N. with wind from W.S.W. in the latter part moderate & wind hauled to N. and foggy

Sunday Oct. 4th

Blow from N.

Strong breeze from N.N.W. and rainy in the first part of the day in the latter part the wind hauled to N. and still rainy we took in all sails and lay to the weather very thick

Remarks on Board Barque C. F. Heath Master on the whaling voyage in South

Monday Oct. 5th

This day begins with fresh breeze from W.N.W. and the Barque Steering about E. and the wind hauled to N.W. in the middle part but in the latter part the wind hauled to S. and light the Barque Steered N.N.W.

Tuesday Oct. 6th

Strong breeze from S.S.W. the Barque Steering N.N.W. in the first of the day in the latter part the wind hauled to S.W. and squally we Steered N.W. by N. Lat. 39-57 Long. 169-30 W.

Wednesday Oct. 7th

Strong breeze from S.W. to W.S.W. and squally all day the Barque Steering N.W. by N. under easy sails the weather is very cold

Thursday Oct. 8th

Strong breeze from S.S.W. in the first part of the day the Barque Steering N.W. by N. and in the latter part we hauled by the wind heading about W. to W.N.W. and weather moderate at Sundown took in sails Lat. 35-50 Long. 170-00 W.

Friday Oct. 9th

Fresh breeze from S.W. in the first of the day & squally middle and latter part quiet pleasant the Barque heading to S.S.E. with all sails out

Saturday Oct. 10th

Strong breeze from S.S.W. and heavy squalls in the first of the day in the latter blowed gale from S. to S.S.W. the Barque under main top sail

Sunday Oct. 11th

Strong breeze from S.S.W. and squally in the first part of the day but in the latter part more moderate the Barque heading to westward under easy sails heading about west Lat. 35-00 Long. 171-00 W.
