

Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan of New Bedford

Monday Oct. 12th

The first part of this day fresh breeze from S.S.W. in the latter part the wind hauled to the W. and the weather very cloudy.

Lat. 35-50 S. Long. 172-30 W.

Tuesday Oct. 13th

Strong breeze from W. and squally in the first part of the day middle and latter part clear but still blowing the wind hauled to S.W. the Barque under easy sails.

Wednesday Oct. 14th

Strong breeze from S.W. and heavy swell from S. in the first part of the day in the latter part the wind hauled to N.W. and squally the Barque under whole top sails steering N.E.

Thursday Oct. 15th

Strong wind from N.W. and thick squally weather all day the Barque under small sails two lower top sail and fore sail.

Friday Oct. 16th

Strong breeze from W. in the first of the day in the latter part the hauled to S.W. and still blowing the Barque under easy sails.

Saturday Oct. 17th

Strong breeze from W.S.W. and squally in the first part of the day the wind hauled to S.S.W. and still blowing and heavy swell running.

Lat. 35-25 Long. 168-25 W.

Sunday Oct. 18th

Strong breeze from S.S.W. in the first of the day and squally in the latter part more moderate but still squally and the wind hauled to S.W. the Barque under lower top sails and courses.

Monday Oct. 19th

Light breeze from S.W. in the first of the day and cloudy weather but in the latter part calm and pleasant we repaired lower main top sail.

Tuesday Oct. 20th

Light breeze from N.W. and smooth the Barque steering S.W. by W. in the first of the day middle and latter part the wind hauled to W. but the weather still pleasant & smooth.

Wednesday Oct. 21st

Strong breeze from N.W. and rugged all day the Barque under whole top sails & courses at sundown took in sails the Barque heading about S.W.

Thursday Oct. 22^d

This day begins with fresh breeze from N.W. and rainy and then became calm in the first of the day middle part the wind hauled to S.W. & still squally in the latter part breeze from N.W. again Barque heading to N.E. at sundown.

Friday Oct. 23^d

Light breeze from W. in the first of the day the Barque steered N. middle part calm but in the latter fine breeze from E. the Barque under all sails.

Lat. 35-47 Long. 169-25 W.

Saturday Oct. 24th

Light breeze from E. in the first of the day and very pleasant in the latter part the same we took our Potatoes on deck and dry them. Cat Poppers and lost him.

Sunday Oct. 25th

Light breeze from N.E. and pleasant in the first of the day middle and latter the same we saw number poppers and got one saw many.
