Light breeze from N.N.W. and pleasant in the first part of the day in the latter the same but the wind hauled to N. and still pleasant
Lat. 35=50 Long. 170=00

Tuesday Oct. 27th
Light breeze from N.W. and pleasant in the first of the day in the latter the same at 2 P.M. we towed Wright whales we lower 3 Boats but no chance raised by stay the
Lat. 35=30 Long. 169=10

Wednesday Oct. 28th
Fresh breeze from N. in the first of the day middle and latter part squally and rainy and the wind hauled to W.N.W.

Thursday Oct. 29th
Fresh breeze from S. and pleasant all day at 5 P.M. saw Wright whales but we did not lower for it was no chance
Lat. 35=37

Friday Oct. 30th
Light breeze from S.E. in the first of the day we saw two ships whalers and one lower Boats in the latter part we gained one of the vessel but we did not see whales

Saturday Oct. 31st
Calm all this day two whalers in sight and we saw some fin back in distance we took them for whales and

Sunday Nov. 1st
This day begins with very light air from N. and cloudy weather middle and latter part fine weather and pleasant saw several in sight we saw number fin backs and another vessel

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Remarks on Board Barque C. F. Keith Master on the whaling voyage South

Monday November 2^d
This begins with light breeze from N. and Pleasant we saw ship and we saw her lower boats and see her whaling about all day but she did not get them at sea down her boat come on board we gained

Tuesday Nov. 3^d
Light breeze from N.W. in the first of the day middle and latter part the same at 4 P.M. saw Wright whales lower three boats but no chance came long side at dark whales raised by Mr. Kling

Wednesday Nov. 4th
Light breeze from N. in the first of the day saw whales lower three boats and chase all day but no chance we lower three times and two more ships whaling

Thursday Nov. 5th
Strong breeze from N. and rainy in first of the day at 10 A.M. saw whales we could not lower in the latter part saw whales again and three Boats no chance

Friday Nov. 6th
Strong breeze from W.N.W. and rugged all day with heavy swell from N. at 4 P.M. saw to windward but we could not get up to them

Saturday Nov. 7th
Strong breeze from N.N.W. all day and cloudy weather the Barque under whole top Sails and courses Lat. 35=52 Long. 170=52 W

Sunday Nov. 8th
Fresh breeze from W.N.W. and quiet cloudy in the first part of the day in the latter the same we saw a few fin back
