

Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan of New Bedford C. F. Keith Master on the whaling voyage

Monday Nov. 9th

Light breeze from W.N.W. in the first of day and foggy in the latter part calm and very smooth the Barque under all sails cruising

Tuesday Nov. 10th

Lat. 37°
Long. 170°
This day begins with light breeze from N. and quiet foggy middle and latter part Raining the Barque under all sails heading E.S.E. and hauled to N.E.

Wednesday Nov. 11th

Fresh breeze from N. in the first of the day and rainy middle part fog but in the latter part quiet clear Steered E.S.E.

Thursday Nov. 12th

Lat. 37°
Long. 167°
Light breeze from N. and quiet thick in the first part of the day in the latter part fresh breeze and clear the Barque heading to eastward Lat. 37-40 Long. 167-00 W.

Friday Nov. 13th

Lat. 35-25
Long. 166-12
Fresh breeze from N. and smooth in the first of the day in the latter part quiet clear & wind hauled N.N.W. the Barque under W. whole topsails heading to Eastward

Saturday Nov. 14th

Fresh breeze from N.N.W. all day and cloudy the Barque heading to East by by the wind with whole top sail and covered down fore fin backs Lat. 37-24 Long. 165-16 W.

Sunday Nov. 15th

Strong breeze from N.E.W. in the first of the day long about 11 A.M. we took in main sail jib and spenker in the latter part more moderate but the weather very thick and cloudy

Monday Nov. 16th

This day begins with light breeze from W.N.W. and then become calm and raining with thick fog until 4 P.M. then cleared up and got little breeze from S.W.

Tuesday Nov. 17th

This day begins with strong breeze from W.S.W. and squally weather we shade sail and steer N. middle and latter part blowed moderate gale we took in sail and eye too took fore top sail at sun down

Wednesday Nov. 18th

Light breeze from W.S.W. in the first of the day the Barque steered E. but in the latter part strong breeze and squally

Thursday Nov. 19th

Lat. 35°
Long. 164°
The first part of the day strong breeze from S.S.W. and squally middle and latter part moderate and clear and the wind hauled S.

Friday Nov. 20th

The first part of this day commences with calm in the latter part light breeze from W.S.W. and Pleasant the Barque heading to South with all sails out Set up jib gages

Saturday Nov. 21st

The first part of this day begins with fine breeze from N.W. and Barque steering S. in the latter part the same at sun down we hauled up S.W. fine & pleasant

Sunday Nov. 22^d

Fresh breeze from N.W. in the first of the day the Barque steering S.W. in the latter part the wind hauled to N.N.W. we steered W.S.W. with all sails out
