Monday Nov. 23^d

This day begins with strong breeze from N. and thick weather with rain. The Bark steering W. by S. at 10 A.M. took in sails in the latter part moderate we made sails again Lat. 38-20 Long. 168-14 W.

Tuesday Nov. 24th

The first part of the day calm middle and latter part light breeze from E. to E.S.E. but the weather look squally. Repaired upper main top sail Bent mizzen stay sail

Wednesday Nov. 25th

Strong breeze and squally all this day the Barque steered W. at 2 P.M. come to by the wind heading about S.S.W. wind S.E.

Thursday Nov. 26th

Moderate gale from S.E. and squally in the first of the day the Barque steered W. by S. under lower main topsail in the latter moderate

Friday Nov. 27th

Fresh breeze from S.E. in the first of the day the Barque steered W. in the latter part quiet pleasant steered W. by S. the weather very cloudy

Saturday Nov. 28th

Light breeze from S.E. all day the Bark steering W. by S. with very pleasant weather we repaired fore sail

Sunday Nov. 29th

This day begins with light breeze from E. in the first of the day but in the latter part of the day fine breeze from S. the Barque made all sails steering W. S. W. the weather has been very smooth but over cast and gloomy

Tuesday December 1st

This day begins with moderate breeze from W. W. and thick weather middle and latter clear up and the wind hauled to S.W.

Wednesday Dec. 2^d

Light breeze and variable with heavy swell from S. the Barque under whole top sails and courses heading the westward

Thursday Dec. 3^d

This day begins with calm and heavy swell from S. in the first of the day but in the latter part breeze from N. the Barque steered S.S.W. come to at Sundown took in sails to lower topsail

Friday Dec. 4th

This day begins with fresh breeze from N.W. and foggy and then commences to rain and blowed hard we took in sail but in the latter part moderate and wind hauled to W.

Saturday Dec. 5th

This day begins with light breeze from S.S.E. and quiet pleasant middle and latter part become squally and wind hauled S.E. the weather very thick

Sunday Dec. 6th

Strong breeze from S.E. in the first part of the day middle and latter part moderate the wind hauled to S.W. and pleasant

Monday Dec. 7th

Strong breeze from W. in the first of the day middle and latter part heavy squally wind hauled to S. we took in fore top sail
