

Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan of

Tuesday Dec. 8th

Strong breeze from S.E.W. to W. all day and squally weather the Barque Cruising under easy sails we saw one vessel heading to E.

Wednesday Dec. 9th

Light wind from S.W. to W. and pleasant all this day the Barque under easy sails Cruising

Thursday Dec. 10th

Light breeze from W. in the first part of the day middle part blowed heavy we took in sails and the W. hauled to W.N.W. in the latter part the same

Friday Dec. 11th

Light and variable wind all day and pleasant the Barque under whole top sails and courses Cruising

Saturday Dec. 12th

Light breeze from N.E. in the first of the day we made sail and steered W. in the latter part the same the weather very pleasant

Sunday Dec. 13th

This begins with light breeze from N. and begins to rain and rained until 9 A.M. the wind hauled to W.S.W. and clear up pleasant all the rest of day

Monday Dec. 14th

Strong breeze from S.W. in the first of the day and heavy swell from S. in the latter part more moderate and wind hauled to W. and cloudy

Tuesday Dec. 15th

This day begins with very strong winds from S.W. and some light squalls of rain we saw one vessel working to E. in the latter part more moderate and wind hauled to S.E. the Barque under two lower top sails

This day begins with light air from S.W. and heavy swell from S. and then become calm at 10:30 A.M. breeze up from N.W. and blowed strong at 3:30 P.M. we took in two up top sail at 5:30 P.M. we raised Land C. east

Thursday Dec. 17th

Strong breeze from W.N.W. in the morning the land Plache in sight we made some sail and steered off N.E. the wind blowed heavy we took in sail and still running in the latter moderate

Friday Dec. 18th

Light breeze from S.E. in the first of the day in the latter part the wind hauled to E. and then became calm the Barque under all sails

Saturday Dec. 19th

Fine breeze from N. in the first of the day & pleasant in the latter part the wind hauled to W.N.W. and still fine

Sunday Dec. 20th

Light winds and variable and day and very Pleasant weather the Barque under all sails

Monday Dec. 21st

Light breeze from W. in the first of the day in the latter part fresh breeze from W.N.W. Cruising

Tuesday Dec. 22^d

Strong breeze from W. in the first part we made sail and E.S.E. all day in the latter part the wind hauled W.N.W.

Wednesday Dec. 23^d

Strong breeze from W.N.W. in the first of the day and cloudy in the latter part the wind hauled to S.E. and the wind still strong and rugged
