Light breeze from E.S.E. in the first of the day we made sail and steered W.N.W. in the latter part steered W. fresh breeze from N.N.E.

Friday Dec. 25<sup>th</sup>

Strong breeze from N.N.E. and rainy in the first of the day middle and latter part thick fog and the wind hauled to N.

Saturday Dec. 26<sup>th</sup>

The first part of this day light breeze from N.N.E. and foggy in the latter part clear the wind hauled to N.W. and pleasant

Sunday Dec. 27<sup>th</sup>

Light breeze from N.W. in the first of the day at 8 A.M. raised whale lower three Boats struck got boat stoven lost whale the line parted

Monday Dec. 28<sup>th</sup>

Light breeze from W.N.W. in the first of the day in the latter part the same we are repairing stoven boat Barque with all sails out

Tuesday Dec. 29<sup>th</sup>

Fresh breeze from W. in the first part of the day the Barque steered E. and S.E. in the latter part more moderate Tank Basted

Wednesday Dec. 30<sup>th</sup>

Strong breeze from W. in the morning at 11 A.M. the wind hauled to S. in the latter part calm we put the boat over

Thursday Dec. 31<sup>st</sup>

Light breeze from N.W. in the first part of the day but in the latter part the wind quiet fresh the Barque under all sails Cruising

Friday Jan. 1<sup>st</sup>

Good weather in the morning with moderate breeze from W.N.W. in the latter part light and clear the wind hauled to W. the Barque with all sails out

Saturday Jan. 2<sup>d</sup>

Fresh breeze from S.E. in the first of the day in the latter part pleasant and the wind hauled to east become very smooth

Sunday Jan. 3<sup>d</sup>

This day commences with calm and cloudy in the first of the day middle and latter part fresh breeze from E. and clear

Monday Jan. 4<sup>th</sup>

Light air from E. to E.N.E. in the first of the day in the latter calm one vessel in sight and we feasted tank put down new one

Tuesday Jan. 5<sup>th</sup>

Strong breeze from S.E. and rugged in the first of the day the Barque under easy sails but in the latter part more moderate

Wednesday Jan. 6<sup>th</sup>

This day begins with fresh breeze from S. but in the latter part blowed strong from S.E. and squally we took in all sails but lower main top sail

Thursday Jan. 7<sup>th</sup>

Strong breeze from E.S.E. in the first part of the day in the latter part more moderate the Barque under whole topsails

Friday Jan. 8<sup>th</sup>

Light breeze from S. in the first part of the day in the latter part the wind hauled to W. and very light most calm the Barque under all sails
