Saturday Jan. 9th

The first part of this 24 hours strong breeze from S. and squally weather in the latter part strong breeze and clear the wind hauled to S.E. the Barque under easy sails

Sunday Jan. 10th

Fresh breeze from S.E. to S.S.E. all day and cloudy by times the Barque under all sails Cruising

Monday Jan. 11th

Light breeze from E. in the first of the day and pleasant in the latter part the same the Barque under all sails

Tuesday Jan. 12th

Light breeze from N.E. in the first of the day and smooth in the latter part same the wind N. and weather pleasant

Wednesday Jan. 13th

Light breeze from N.W. and pleasant in the first of the day in the latter part the wind hauled to W. the weather is the same

Thursday Jan. 14th

The first part of this 24 hours one rain squalls and strong breeze from S.S.E. in the latter part fine breeze and cloudy

Friday Jan. 15th

Light breeze from N.W. and pleasant in the first of the day in the latter part cloudy but smooth and the weather rainy

Saturday Jan. 16th

This day begins with light breeze from W. and then become calm in the latter part the wind hauled to S. and S.E. and the weather cloudy we scrap the ship out side

Sunday Jan. 17th

Light breeze from E.N.E. and pleasant in the first part of the day in the latter part the same the wind hauled to N.E.

Monday Jan. 18th

Light breeze and variable with very pleasant weather we run over one boat and painted him

Tuesday Jan. 19th

Fresh breeze from S.S.E. in the first of the day in the latter part the wind hauled to S.E. and clear weather all sails out Cruising

Wednesday Jan. 20th

This day begins with calm and then light breeze from N.W. and pleasant the Barque steered E. by N. about all day in latter part fresh breeze

Thursday Jan. 21st

Light breeze from W.N.W. in the first part of the day in the latter part the wind hauled to S.E. and still pleasant Barque with all sails out

Friday Jan. 22nd

Light breeze from N. in the first of the day in the morning we saw a merchant vessel and Captain sent mate on board of her for news in the latter part fresh breeze from N.W. Barque with all sails out

Saturday Jan. 23rd

This day begins with fresh breeze N.W. in the first of the day at 5 A.M. raised whale going to windward very fast no chance to lower boats we made sail but we could not come up with him in the latter part fine weather the wind about N.W. at sun down calm Lat. 37-40
