

Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan of New Bedford Co. F. Keith Master on the whaling

Sunday Jan. 24th

This day begins with fresh breeze from E. in the first of the day in the latter part more moderate the Barque steered to N.

Monday Jan. 25th

Fresh breeze from E. in the first of the day at 930 A.M. Saw whaler in the latter part the wind hauled to N.N.W. we are gamed Barque

Tuesday Jan. 26th

Fresh breeze from N. in the first of the day at 1045 A.M. Saw whales we lowered three boats but no chance the whales going to North east in the latter part the same raised by station

Wednesday Jan. 27th

Strong breeze from N. to N.N.W. in the first part of the day in the latter part the same at 3 P.M. Raised whales we lowered three Boats W.B. Struck and first mate got Stoven and then the second mate line patted the whale we cut off Spouting Blood

Thursday Jan. 28th

Strong breeze from N.N.W. and S. S. W. middle and latter part moderate and smooth the wind hauled to N.W.

Friday Jan. 29th

Strong breeze from N. and rainy in the first of the day we took in Top Sails in latter part quiet clear but strong wind

Saturday Jan. 30th

Strong breeze from N.N.W. to N.W. all day the Barque under easy sails cruising the weather rainy

Sunday Jan. 31st

This day begins with strong breeze from W. in the first of the day in the latter part more moderate and wind hauled to W.S.W.

Monday Feb. 1st

Light breeze from S. in the first of the day middle and latter part the same we change boats took in a Stoven one

Tuesday Feb. 2nd

Fresh breeze from S. and the wind hauling to S.E. in the first of the day in the latter part quiet smooth and cloudy wind E.

Wednesday Feb. 3rd

Light breeze from E. in the first part of the day in the latter part the wind hauled to E.N.E. and then N.E. about sun down the Bark heading to S.E.

Thursday Feb. 4th

Light breeze from N.E. all this day the Barque under all sails cruising the weather very pleasant Lat. 37-44 Long. 179-22 E.

Friday Feb. 5th

This day begins with light breeze from N. and pleasant in the latter part the same the wind hauled to N.E. the Bark steering S.E. by S. with all sails out

Saturday Feb. 6th

Fresh breeze from N.E. in the first part of the day in the middle part rainy and then the wind hauled to S.W. in the latter part quiet clear but fresh breeze the Barque S.E. by S. and S.S.E.

Sunday Feb. 7th

Light breeze from E. in the first of the day in the latter part the wind hauled to S.S.E. the Bark under all sails Lat. 41-44 Long. 178-42
