Remarks on Board Barque C. W. Morgan

Monday Feb. 8th

Light breeze E. in the first part of day at A.M. Saw whales we lower three boats the struck one we took him along side and commence cutting. Patted Pen nant we put up another S. B.

Tuesday Feb. 9th

This day begins with fresh breeze from N. we commence to cut our whale but we did finish in the latter strong breeze and regged the wind from the same quarter

Wednesday Feb. 10th

Strong breeze from N. and rainy we got true Cullen in the latter part moderate but the wind hauled to S.W.

Thursday Feb. 11th

Strong breeze from S.S.E. and squally in the first part of the day in the latter part more moderate and we are boiling

Friday Feb. 12th

This begins with light air from S. and quiet foggy in the first part of the day middle part calm in the latter part light air from S. we still boiling

Saturday Feb. 13th

Light breeze from N.E. in the first of the day in the latter part fresh breeze from greater we got true boiling

Sunday Feb. 14th

Strong breeze from N.E. in the first part of the day the Bark Staved S. under easy sails in the latter part the same but the very cloudy and quiet regged

Fresh breeze from N.E. in the first part of the day in the latter part fine weather and smooth and hauled to N. 100 Barrels

Tuesday Feb. 16th

This begins with Strong breeze from N. and rain Thunder and Lightning in the first part of the day middle and latter part moderate and thick at 2 P.M. Saw the Island of Chatham and the wind hauled to N.W. the Barque under all sails

Wednesday Feb. 17th

This day begins with fresh breeze from N.E. to N. and foggy in the first part of the day in the latter part more moderate the Barque working to North in Passage between Chatham and Pils

Thursday Feb. 18th

Strong breeze from E. with heavy rain and fog in the first of the day middle part light up little we saw land but in the latter become foggy again and wind from N.E.

Friday Feb. 19th

This day commences with calm and thick fog middle and latter the same but we got sight of the land once

Saturday Feb. 20th

Light breeze from E. and thick fog in the first part part in the latter part cleared up some but commence raining we saw the Island

Sunday Feb. 21st

Light breeze from N.E. and thick fog in the first part of the day middle and latter part strong breeze from N.N.W. to W. we made land and stood in come to Ananther at 6.30 P.M. in Chatham Island the wind Strong and still foggy 14 1/2 fathom water
