Monday Mar. 22^d

Strong S.W. winds and heavy squall the ship steering E. with main top sail out in the first of the day middle and latter part the wind hauled to N.W. and still squally set main top gallant sail Lat. 49=37 Long. 111=40

Tuesday Mar. 23^d

Strong westerly winds and heavy squalls the Barque steering E. to E. by N. under two lower top sails and fore sail at 11-10 P.M. core away and Long 107=40 W. der gear and we came to on the Port tack and took in all sails

Wednesday Mar. 24th

Strong winds from W.S.W. with fleck squalls and rain we went to work and making a sudden in the latter part more moderate at 6 P.M. we got true and made some sail and steered E. by N. Lat. 50=34 Long. 105=00

Thursday Mar. 25th

This day commences with light from N.W. to S. in the first of the day and rainy middle and latter part quiet clear and pleasant we took down fore sail and commenced repairing of it the steering E. by N. Lat. 50=34 Long. 103=34

Strong winds from N. and foggy weather in the first part of the day in the latter part clear up and became fine weather the Barque steering E. by N. the wind hauled to N.W. Lat. 52=52 Long 90=22 W.

Monday Mar. 29th

Strong breeze from N.W. and clear weather in the first part of the day the Barque steering E. by N. middle part squally in the latter part clear the about W. we steered E. by N. Lat. 53=49 Long. 86=52 W.

Tuesday Mar. 30th

This day begins with light breeze from W. the Barque steering E. by N. middle and latter part the wind to N.W. and squally Lat. 54=04 Long. 81=08 W.

Wednesday Mar. 31st

Light breeze from W. and fine rain in the first of the day the Barque steering E. by N. with main top gallant sail out latter part strong and squally Lat. 54=48 Long 76=35 W.
