by E. Lat. 8-09 Long. 32-14

Sunday May 9th

Fine breeze from S.E. and Barque Steer-
ing N. by E. in the first part of the day
in the latter part the wind light and
quiet smooth Lat. 6-34 Long. 32-26

Monday May 10th

Fresh breeze from S.E. all this 24 hours the
Barque Steered W. by N. and N.W. and N.
W. by N. all in side of 12 hours Lat 5-15-

Tuesday May 11th

Fine breeze from S.E. in the first of the day
at 4.30 A.M. the wind hauled to S.W. the
Barque Steering W. by N. at 5 A.M. we made
main land Cape St. Roque we went on
Board of two Schooners Saw many fish
Boats Lat. 4-46 Long. 35-11

Wednesday May 12th

Light breeze from S.E. the Barque Steering
N.W. in the first part of the day at 10.30 A.M. Saw
a small Boat in the latter part very light winds
at 5 P.M. Saw land and the same boat in sight
Lat. 3-48 Long. 36-49

Thursday May 13th

The first part of this 24 hours light air from E. the
Barque Steered N. middle part rain & squalls
in the latter part pleasant Lat. 2-51 S.

Friday May 14th

Light breeze from N.E. to N.N.E. in the first
of the day middle part squally the wind ha-
yled to S. and then S.E. the Barque Steered
N.N.E. course with all sails out
Lat. 1-50 S.

The first part of this day fresh breeze from E.
to S.E. and squally the Barque Steering N.N.E.
in the latter part the same Lat. 00-10 miles S

Sunday May 16th

The first part of these 24 hours fresh breeze
from S.E. and rainy the Barque Steered
N.N.E. in the latter part clear up we Cape
off N.

Monday May 17th

Light and variable wind in doldrums all
this 24 hours the Barque Steering N. the weather
rainy and squally Lat. 1-54 N.

Tuesday May 18th

This begins with fresh breeze and heavy rain
in the first part in the latter part fine breeze
from E. to S.E. Barque Steering N. Lat. 2-58
N.

Wednesday May 19th

This day begins with light airs and calms in
the first part in the latter part light breeze
from N.N.E. the Barque heading about N.W.
Lat. 3-17 Long. 38-01

Thursday May 20th

All this 24 hours light winds and calm the
Barque heading to N.W. and N.N.W. the wind
easily

Friday May 21st

Light breeze from E. all this 24 hours the Barque
Steering N. with all sails out we commence
Painting ship Lat. 4-23 N.

Saturday May 22^d

This day commence with fresh breeze from
E. the Barque Steering N. and the wind
hauled to the N.E. and little squally we
suppose to be Trade wind at 7 A.M. we
Cape off and Steered N.W.
Lat. 6-00 N Long. 40-11 W.
