Brig Charlotte From S. Francisco

Friday Aug 6<sup>th</sup> 1852

Commenced with light winds from the North and hazy weather laying in San Francisco 3 1/2. Well took our anchors and stood out & kept off to South & set the watch Middle Part Strong winds from the S. E. 1/4 W. Latter Part from the S. W. Steering S. E. with all sail set Employed in Ships duty

Saturday Aug 7<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with strong winds from the S. W. and clear weather Steering S. E. with all sail set hands Employed in various jobs Middle Part much the same Latter Part more moderate Steering S. E. by S To Ends in Latitude 32.47 N Long 120.45

Sunday Aug 8<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with light winds from the S. W. and thick hazy weather Steering S. E. by S with all sail set hands Employed in various jobs Middle and Latter Part clear weather Latter Part clear weather with all sail set hands at this time thus Ends with nothing more Remarkable
