First Part of this day light winds from the N.W. and clear weather Steering S.E. by S. with all sail set hands employed in Ships duty Middle Part much the same Latter Part thick hazy weather & at 11 went to the fore top gallant sail to repair

So Ends with nothing more remarkable

Tuesday Aug 10th

First Part of this day light winds from the N.W. and hazy weather Steering S.E. by S. with all drawing sail set 5 P.M. finished the fore top gallant sail and bent it Middle Part much the same,

as first Latter Part fresh breezes from N.W. Steering S.E. Employed in Repairing the Old main sail So Ends Lat 28.00
Long 118.21 W

Wednesday Aug 11

First Part of this day light breezes from the N.W. and hazy weather Steering S.E. with all drawing sail set Middle and Latter Part much the same Employed in Repairing the Old main sail this ends Lat 25.28 N
Long 117.16 W

Thursday Aug 12th

First Part of this day light airs from the N.W. and hazy weather Steering S.E. by E with all drawing sail set Employed in Repairing the old main sail 6 P.M. finished it and stowed it away Middle and Latter Part light airs and hazy this ends in Lat 24.21 North
Long by set 15.11 W. S.T.

Friday Aug 13th

First Part of this day light winds from the N.W. and clear pleasant weather Steering S.E. by E with all drawing sail set Employed in Ships duty Middle Part much the same Latter Part winds from the N. set the ribs and try sail Employed in making Spungarn and other Jobs nothing more remarkable Lat 23.11 N
Long 115.02 W

Saturday Aug 14th

First Part of this day light winds from the North and cloudy weather Steering S.E. by East with all drawing sail set Middle and Latter Part much the same Employed in making Spungarn and other small Jobs So Ends this day Lat 21.49 North
Long 113.44 W

Sunday Aug 15th

First Part of this day light winds from the N.E. and fine clear weather Steering S.E. by E 4 P.M. hauled up E by South & braced the yards and took in the Lower studding sail Middle and Latter Part moderate breezes hands at leisure nothing in sight So Ends this day Lat 19.56 N
Long 112.37 W

Monday Aug 16th

First Part of these 24 hours light airs and calms Steering E. by S with all sail set wind from N.E. Middle and Latter Part wind from N.W. to N. with clear weather 11 A.M. saw porpoises struck down and lost them by traw drawing Employed in various Jobs So ends this day with nothing more remarkable Lat 20.31 N
Long 111.15 W
