Friday Oct 29th
Light winds and fine weather. Sailing in
Tumbes Employed in Ships Safety
7 A.M. all hands came on board
11 the Capt came off to go to sea. To Ends

Saturday Oct 30th
Commenced with light winds from the
Westward and fine weather. Sailing at
Tumbes with a full cargo of Potatoes
on board at Sun set took our anchor
and got under way and stood out
to the N.W. with all sail set day light saw
the Island of Santa Clara bearing East
Dist 8 miles Employed in Staking the
Cables Stowing away wood water and
other Jobs to Ends this day etc

Sunday Oct 31st
Commenced with light winds from the
West and fine weather. Steering by the
wind heading N.E. with all sail set
4 P.M. tack'd Ship to the South and
at 11th day light saw Santa Clara Island
bearing East dist 10 miles all hands at
work to Ends heading from N to S.W.
No Observations

Monday Nov 1st
Commenced with light winds from the N.W.
and hazy weather with a heavy swell on
steering by the wind heading South with all
drawing sail set 9 P.M. wore Ship to the
N.W. middle and latter Part steering
West with strong winds from the
Southward. Employed in various Jobs
this Ends Sat by Obs 3.00
Long by Act 82.10th

Tuesday Nov 2nd
Commenced with strong winds from the South and
hazy weather. Steering West middle Part much
the same latter Part light winds and even cast
sky 7 A.M. set the Starboard fore topmast and
main top gallant standing sail to Ends No Observations

Towards San Francisco in 1852

Wednesday Nov 3rd
Commenced with light winds from the South
and thick hazy weather. Steering West
with all drawing sail set middle Part
latter Part much the same Employed
in picking Oakum making a fore top
gallant mast and other Jobs etc Obs
this day Sat by Act 2.105 long 8.5th

Thursday Nov 4th
Commenced with light winds from the
S.W. Southward and thick hazy weather
with some rain. Steering West
middle and latter Part much the same
Employed in picking Oakum making the
fore top gallant mast etc. To Ends
this day in Latitude 02.33 South
Longitude 87.00 W

Friday Nov 5th
Strong winds and hazy with frequent
squalls of rain from the South. Steering
by the wind heading N.W. day light
made Chatham Island bearing W.S.W.
dist 8 miles 7 A.M. kept off N.W. with
all sail set to Ends Sat by Obs 00.22
Long by Chron 89.28 W

Saturday Nov 6th
Strong winds from the South and thick
hazy weather. Steering W.S.W. with
all sail set 2 P.M. saw Porter's Island
bearing S.W. dist 15 miles Sun set saw
James Island bearing W.S.W. kept off N.W.
at midnight saw ~~the~~ Abbermarly Island
bearing South dist 8 miles 1 P.M. started
sail and wore Ship to the East 4 A.M. wore
to the N.W. day light made Abington Island
bearing South dist 15 miles 6 A.M. made
all sail starting W.S.W. hands employ-
ed in various Jobs saw a school
of sperm whales N.W. from Abington
Island. To Ends this day
Sat by Obs 1.11 South
Long by Chron 91.48 W
