

Brig Charlotte From Lumbes,

Bound To San Francisco in Nov 1852

Tuesday Nov 16th

Commenced with light winds from the N and rainy weather steering W by N with all sail set middle and latter Part light winds from the S.W. and clear weather heading W.N.W. employed in ship duty so ended the day Lat 9.08 N Long 99.18 W

Wednesday Nov 17th

Commenced with light winds from the W.N.W. and clear weather heading S.W. & P.M. Tacked to the N and took in the Boat middle Part wind from the S.W. steering N.W. with rain latter Part light winds from the South steering N.W. by W with strong Lat Saw Black Fish in large schools so ended this day No Obs this day

Thursday Nov 18th

Commenced with moderate winds from the South and rainy weather steering N.W. by W with all sail set middle Part much the same latter Part calm and rainy employed in ship duty nothing in sight so ended this day with rainy weather so Obs Lat by G. 10.40 N Long 100.10 West

Friday Nov 19th

First Part of this day Calm and rainy middle Part light winds from the E.N.E. steering W.N.W. with all sail set latter Part much the same so ended the day Latitude 11.10 N

Saturday Nov 20th

First Part light winds from the E.N.E. and fine clear weather steering W.N.W. with all sail set middle Part much the same Calm employed in fitting and bending the best main topsail and mainsail latter Part light winds from the East with Thunder and lightning some rain so ended Lat 11.36 N Long 101.30 W

Sunday Nov 21st

First Part of this day light winds and squally from all points of the Compass with Thunder and lightning and frequent squall of rain middle Part moderate breezes from the E.N.E. steering W.N.W. with all sail set latter Part strong breezes from the S.E. and fine clear weather so ended this day nothing in sight Lat by Obs 12.05 N Long by Chron 103.24 W

Monday Nov 22nd

First Part of this day strong winds from the East and clear weather steering N.W. by W with all sail set middle Part squally weather with much rain wind from E to N.E. all sail set employed in various jobs Lat by Obs 13.10 N Long 104.01

Tuesday Nov 23rd

First Part of this day strong winds from the E.N.E. with heavy squalls of rain and rain steering N.W. with all sail set P.M. took in the main top gallant and lower studding sails day light set the main top gallant studding sail latter Part rainy with light winds from E to N.E. Lat by Obs 14.38 N Long 105.01

Wednesday 24th

light winds and rainy weather from S.E. to N.E. with heavy squalls at times forenoon the E.S.E. steering N.W. by W employed in & overhauling Tatatan a and ship duty Lat 15.35 N Long 106.28 W

Thursday Nov 25th

First Part heavy squally from the S.E. with rain middle Part light winds latter Part moderate gales from the N.W. and clear weather steering N.W. by W with heavy W.S.W. Lat 16.28 N Long 107.26 W
