First Part of this day moderate gales from the N.W. and clear weather steering by the wind heading W.N.W. with whole top sails fore sail 9th and try sail set

Middle Part more moderate Employed in Overhauling Potatoes and finding many bad ones Latter Part strong winds from the N.E.W. and dry weather nothing in sight Lat 15-50 Long 108-58

Saturday Nov 27

First Part strong winds from the N by E.W. and fine weather and a heavy swell from the N.W. steering by the wind heading W by N with whole top sails set

Middle Part light winds and Buggy Latter Part light winds from the N.W. and pleasant weather heading W with all sail set Employed in Overhauling Potatoes in the fore and after hold so ends this day no obs.

To San Francisco In November 1852

Sunday Nov 28th

First Part light winds from the N.E.W. and fine pleasant weather heading West with all sail set Middle Part heading W.N.W. Latter Part heading N.W. with brisk trades nothing in sight Employed in Sunday jobs so ends Lat 16-21 Long 111-07 W

Monday Nov 29th

First Part of this day light winds from the N.E.E. and fine clear weather steering by the wind heading N.W. Middle Part much the same Latter Part strong trades from the N.E. steering N.W. by N Employed in taking out Potatoes out of the fore hold and stowing them in the fore castle all hands having steamed aft Lat by Obs 17-08 Long by Obs 112-07 W

Tuesday Nov 30th

First Part of this day strong trades from the N.E. and clear weather steering N.W. by N Middle and Latter Part steering N.W. with strong trades nothing in sight Remarkable Employed as yesterday so ends Lat by Obs 18-33 Long 113-19 W
