Wednesday Dec 1st 1852.

First Part of the day strong winds from the N.E. and clear weather steering S.W. with the main top gallant sail set Employed in Overhauling Potatoes Middle and Latter Part much the same So Ends 11

Lat 19° 53' Long 114° 40'

Thursday Dec 2nd

First Part of this day light winds from N. to N.E. heading N.W. and W.N.W. with all drawing sail set Middle and Latter Part much the same So Ends 11

Lat 20° 48' Long 115° 31'

Friday Dec 3rd

First Part strong winds from the North heading W.N.W. Middle Part light and heading N.W. Stating the sail to pieces Middle and Latter Part

Much the same So Ends Lat 21° 32' Long 118° 17'

Saturday Dec 4th

Moderate breezes from N. to N.E. heading from W.N.W. to N.W. with the main top gallant sail set the Watch Employed in Overhauling Potatoes So Ends Lat 21° 48' Long 118° 45'

San Francisco In December 1852.

Sunday Dec 5th

First Part strong winds from the North and N.W. heading N.W. Employed in Overhauling Potatoes Middle and Latter Part much the same Lat 22° 31' Long 121° 05'

Monday Dec 6th

Strong winds from the N. and N.E. steering by the wind heading from N.W. to N.W. by West under whole topsails clear sky and fine weather Employed as usual This Day Lat 23° 46' Long 122° 50'

Tuesday Dec 7th

Moderate gales from the N by E heading N.W. by W under whole topsails canvas rib and try sail so ends with clear weather wind increasing Lat 24° 47' Long 124° 38'

Wednesday Dec 8th

Moderate gale from the North with clear pleasant weather and a heavy swell on S.W. doubled Reaped the topsails middle and Latter Part moderate gale from the N by E heading N.W. by W Lat 25° 50' Long 126° 05'
