with light breezes from E & E at 7 1/2 a.m. headed
to go by Sible left top sails at 9 o'clock
Main course and Sible and two reefed the
top sails

Monday August 10 1846

sail

weather and light breezes from S.W. & E at 4 P.M.
Course E & S

Last part fine but cloudy weather
and light breezes from S.W. steering E & S by the
wind saw a Boatsman steering S.W. spoke a Brig
and a Schooner bound to Barbados with
sitting up the vessel and off stage

Thursday August 13 1846
