

10 *Boat Cherokee* from the West Islands towards  
Wednesday September 3 1846

27 *Boat* with fine hot  
clear weather and light breezes from S E beating  
by the wind to S W at 6 P M the South point  
of Sencera here some distant 25 miles

Middle part fair but  
cloudy with variable breezes from S E  
Last part cloudy with squally  
rainy weather and light breezes from E S E beating  
by the wind to S E 6 M M S L with much  
employed Latitude of 13 37 47 S  
Longitude from Chud 26 15 W

Thursday August 3 1846

28 *Boat* with cloudy weather  
and light breezes from S E steering by the wind to S W  
sent about the Sea top Gallant stay to Michael's here  
E distant 20 miles at 2 P M

Middle part fair but  
cloudy with light breezes  
Last part cloudy with light  
breezes all day sail set up the mainmast  
topping with variously employed S M S L  
Latitude of 13 36 37 S  
Longitude from Chud 26 48 W

Friday September 4 1846

29 *Boat* with cloudy squally  
weather with light breezes and rain at intervals  
wind S E steering S W by the wind

Middle part cloudy with  
light breezes from S W steering E S E saw a King  
at day light

Last part cloudy with light breezes  
from S W steering E S E and S E by E with frequent  
rain squalls two men sick with variously  
employed Latitude of 13 35 55 S  
Longitude from Chud 26 10 W

the Cape de Meads Jacob L Cleveland Master  
Saturday September 5 1846

30 *Boat* with fine weather and  
dark breezes from S W steering S E by E  
Middle part slightly with  
Heavy rains and fresh breezes from S W steering  
S E by E

Last part cloudy with fair weather  
and strong breezes from S W set up the Sea top  
Mast and S W 7 Jells black and hoisted two sail  
and set them saw one sail two men sick  
Latitude of 13 34 56 S  
Longitude from Chud 26 21 W

Sunday September 6 1846

*Boat* with fine weather and  
fresh breezes from S W steering S W saw two sail  
off the weather S W

31 Middle part fine but cloudy  
weather and dark breezes

Last part pleasant weather and  
fine breezes from S W steering S W saw two sail  
one man sick all day sail set

Latitude of 13 33 45 S  
Longitude from Chud 26 48 W  
Sunday September 7 1846

32 *Boat* with fine weather and  
light breezes from S W steering S W saw a school of  
black fish but no porpoise

Middle part full breezes and  
calm

Last part pleasant weather  
and calm set up the Sea top rigging and down  
and Adams sick with a green vomit the  
gun teams kept to leave the rigging

Latitude of 13 33 13 S  
Longitude from Chud 26 36 W
