

14 Barque Cherokee from the Western Islands  
Tuesday September 15 1846

40 Com<sup>o</sup> with fine weather  
and high trades saw a sail  
Middle part strong trades  
and cloudy course of 1/2 N  
Last part fine weather with  
strong trades and scattering clouds pointed  
the starboard boat southward off duty and ENE  
watch variously employed

Latitude by obs 24° 16' N  
Longitude by obs 26° 55' W

Wednesday September 16 1846

41 All these 24 hours strong  
trades and cloudy weather set a N by E  
steering sail course by W and from ENE to  
ENE with variously employed hands with off duty

Latitude by obs 21° 40' N  
Longitude by obs 27° 01' W

Thursday September 17 1846

42 All these 24 hours strong  
trades and cloudy weather steering 1/4 E all  
Leaving sail set watch employed in ships  
Duty divided the gages, fire & stoke chains

Latitude by obs 19° 20' N  
Longitude by obs 26° 10' W

Friday September 18 1846

43 Com<sup>o</sup> with strong trades and  
cloudy weather steering 1/2 S saw a sail  
Middle part strong trades  
and cloudy

Last part strong trades and  
cloudy weather, saw two sail watch employed  
in ships duty all day sail set watch of  
duty saw gages used  
Latitude by obs 16° 05' N  
Longitude by obs 25° 27' W

Traverse the Cape de Verde I S Cleveland Martin  
Saturday September 19 1846

44 All the day light sails and  
cloudy with variously employed getting a new boat  
He saw two sail watch set off duty Michael  
Muller sick

Latitude by obs 15° 08' N  
Longitude by obs 25° 20' W

Sunday September 20 1846

45 Com<sup>o</sup> with cloudy weather and  
small breezes and some rain saw black fish boat, the  
boat and caught one saw a sail steering 1/2 W by the  
wind it being SE

Middle part cloudy with  
rain and small breezes from the westward steering  
Last part cloudy and rainy  
with small breezes from over steering 1/2 E

Latitude by obs 14° 15' N  
Longitude by obs 24° 20' W

Monday September 21 1846

46 Com<sup>o</sup> with cloudy weather and  
light breezes from W steering 1/2 W  
Middle part cloudy with  
rain and light breezes steering 1/2 E and saw  
breezes from SE steering 1/2 E hoisted the blackfishes  
blades and the cutting pendant

Latitude by obs 13° 02' N  
Longitude by obs 24° 24' W

Tuesday September 22 1846

47 Com<sup>o</sup> with fine but cloudy  
weather and light breezes from over steering 1/2 E  
Middle part cloudy with small  
breezes from W with some rain saw a pilot  
Last part cloudy with light breezes  
from SW to SE steering 1/2 the wind to SE course  
very true the log employed in making a run  
on Lat 12° 18' N long 23° 36' W
