cloudy weather with squalls at intervals. watch  
rainy employed Helt off duty still set to W  
Latitude 9° 18' 30" S  
Longitude for time

Tuesday October 13 1846

70) Cont. with strong trades from  
S E steering by the wind to S W  
Middle put down  
with cloudy weather and strong breezes  
Saw part cloudy with  
birds. trades watch rainy employed Helt off  
duty still  
Latitude 9° 18' 30" S  
Longitude for time

Wednesday October 14 1846

71) All this day fair but  
cloudy with strong trades from S E steering  
by the wind to S W watch rainy employed  
Helt off duty still saw a porpoise  
Latitude 9° 18' 30" S  
Longitude for time 179° 10' W

Thursday October 15 1846

72) All this day strong trades  
and squally weather wind S E steering  
by the wind to S W saw a porpoise  
watch rainy employed  
Latitude 9° 18' 30" S  
Longitude for time 179° 5' W

South, Jacob L Cleveland Master 21  
Friday October 16 1846

73) All this day cloudy with strong  
breezes from S E and squalls at intervals steering to  
S W saw light rain in through the night  
poked over the potatoes  
Latitude 9° 19' 36" S  
Longitude for time 178° 50' W

Saturday October 17 1846

74) All this day strong trades from  
S E and squally steering by the wind to S W  
all prudent sail set watch rainy employed  
saw a porpoise  
Latitude 9° 19' 39" S  
Longitude for time 178° 35' W

Sunday October 18 1846

75) First part of this day cloudy with  
birds. trades from S E steering by the wind  
Middle put cloudy with light  
squally trades  
Latitude 9° 19' 39" S  
Longitude for time 178° 24' W

Monday October 19 1846

76) All these 24 hours fair weather  
and birds breezes from S E steering by the wind  
drawing sail set put up the head rigging  
saw a porpoise  
Latitude 9° 19' 39" S  
Longitude for time 178° 10' W

Tuesday October 20 1846

77) fair with fine weather and  
birds breezes from S E steering by the wind  
middle put with the sun  
Last part cloudy and squally with rain  
sent up the cutting pendant and steering to S E  
Latitude 20° 5' 2" South Longitude for time 177° 30' W
