

Began Chumker Bence South
Wednesday October 27

84 Cont^d with a strong gale from SW
and a heavy sea with cloudy squally rainy weather
at 10 AM took in studds & covered top galls and single reefed the
top sail Head E of S
Middle part much the same
with rain

Last part cloudy with a strong
gale and squally weather with rain at intervals &
a high sea on the fore course and the top sail
with the fore jib sail employed in flogging
the fore yard

Latitude 44° 03' 44" S
Longitude 130° 01' 13" W

Thursday October 28 1846

85 Cont^d with cloudy squally
weather and strong gales with a high sea
sent up the fore yard but the sail and
a two reefed fore top sail on it at 5 PM
at 7 reefed the fore top sail and set the fore
Middle part much the same

Last part rain but cloudy and
squally with a high sea on fore shore to the
strong S of E all fore sail put toward the
fore boat

Latitude 44° 05' 02" S
Longitude 130° 04' 55" W

Friday October 29 1846

86 Cont^d with cloudy squally
weather and a high sea and strong breeze
from SW at 10 AM steering S of E at 2 PM the stern
E of S at 6 made all sail

Middle part much the same
same

Last part cloudy squally with strong
gales from SW steering E of S all shrouds
set Latitude 44° 05' 56" S Longitude 130° 04' 30" W

Friday October 30 1846

87 Cont^d with strong gales from SW
and cloudy squally weather saw a finback at 6 PM
took in studds & covered top galls and single reefed the
top sail Head E of S

Middle part strong gales and
and squally headed S of E spruce in course two reefed the
top sail at 2 AM at 3 close reefed and headed the
fore top sail at 4 split the fore course from clew to main

Last part a heavy gale from
SW & heading to E of the wind with cloudy squally
rainy weather

Latitude 44° 06' 14" S
Longitude 130° 04' 10" W

Saturday October 31 1846

87 Cont^d with a heavy gale from SW &
and a high sea with rainy squally weather at 2 PM
rather moderate with heading to SW we split the fore top
mast stay sail from head to foot at 6 PM set a reef
off the fore top sail by 10 W of the wind

Middle part moderate kept
off E wind down made sail at day light

Last part rain but cloudy with
fine breezes from SW that a new fore course and fore
top mast stay sail saw a finback parted the fore rope
of the fore top sail all staying sail set

Latitude 44° 05' 58" S
Longitude 130° 04' 00" W

Sunday November 1 1846

89 Cont^d with fair but cloudy weather
and fine breezes from W steering E of S & saw finbacks
Middle part cloudy with small breezes
all staying sail set at 5 AM squally

Last part cloudy and squally with
rain and variable breezes from W all fore sail set

Latitude 44° 05' 36" S
Longitude 130° 04' 54" W
