

Barge Cherokee Bound round the Cape of  
Monday November 3 1846

90 *Course* with cloudy squally weather  
and high breezes from S.W. steering E.S.E. saw pinbacks  
porpoises and birds

Middle part cloudy with squalls  
at intervals

Last part fair with high breezes  
from W.S.W. steering E.S.E. all drawing sail set  
watch rained employed mended the fore top mast  
stay sail saw pinbacks

Latitude 40° 55' 20" S

Longitude per chron 100° 10' W

Tuesday November 3 1846

91 *Course* with cloudy squally weather  
and high breezes finished the old stay sail & changed  
over fore top sail saw pinbacks

Middle part cloudy with high  
breezes

Last part cloudy with strong breezes  
took the studds at 10 a.m. hauled up the fore sail  
and main top galls at 11 at noon two repair  
the top sails began to repair the old fore course

Latitude 40° 55' 30" S

Longitude per chron 100° 00' E

Wednesday November 4 1846

92 *Course* with a strong increasing  
gale from S.W. steering E.S.E. with rain and squally  
weather hauled side spanker on course and close reefed  
the fore top sail at 12 m at 4 hauled fore top sail  
and close reefed the main turned up the studds

Middle part a strong gale from  
at 9 2 m hauled fore course fore top stay sail and  
began to reef the main

Latitude 51° 32'

Longitude 49° 57' strong gale from S.W. at 8 a.m. kept off E.S.E.  
set the fore course and let one reef off the main top  
sail at 10 put the fore top sail turned up the studds

Good Hope Jacob S Cleveland Master  
Thursday November 5 1846

93 *Course* with a strong gale from  
N.W. steering E.S.E. with cloudy squally weather and  
a high sea

Middle part moderate made  
sail as required

Last part fair with high  
decreasing breezes from W.S.W. all drawing sail  
set saw porpoises

Latitude 40° 55' 36" South

Longitude per chron 60° 35' E

Friday November 6 1846

94 All this day fair weather and  
light breezes from S.W. steering E.S.E.  
saw pinbacks and a sail mended the fore sail  
and began the top sail all drawing sail set

Latitude 40° 55' 21" S

Longitude per chron 90° 00' E

Saturday November 7 1846

95 All this day fair weather  
and small breezes from S.W. steering E.S.E.  
finished the old top sail saw pinbacks

Latitude 40° 55' 07" S

Longitude per chron 90° 00' E

Sunday November 8 1846

96 *Course* with fine weather and  
calm

Middle part fine weather and  
small breezes from W. steering E.S.E. all drawing  
sail set

Last part fine weather and  
high air saw porpoises caught one

Latitude 40° 55' 45" S

Longitude per chron 90° 55' E
