light heels from 4th Steer to E of the line saw fish
made all sail at daylight

Monday December 14 1846

Cont. with fine but cloudy weather and small
calm saw porpoises

Middle part fine weather and small
heels from SE Steer ESE

Last part fine but cloudy weather
and high heels from SE Steer ESE saw fish

Latitude by obs 37.58 South

Longitude per chron 76.54 E

Tuesday December 15 1846

Cont. with fine but cloudy weather
and high heels from SE Steer ESE saw a sail
standing to SW at 4 PM saw Amsterdam or St Pauls
Island bearing E of S distant 10 or 12 leagues.

138 saw fish

Middle part cloudy with light heels
by off under light sail

Last part cloudy and foggy with
light heels from SE Steer in shore and sent two
boats sailing

Wednesday December 16 1846

Cont. with cloudy foggy weather and
high heels from SE the boats came off about 12 PM
with about 10 lbs each stood off and cleared fish
and sailed themselves a sail stand to SE of the
line fish to north of the island

Last part fine weather and light
heels from SE and saw many colors saw porpoises
