Tuesday January 5 1847

Latitude by obs 40° 56'S
Longitude from chron 112° 40'E

Cont. with cloudy weather and
fresh heaves from W steering ESE

Last part cloudy with a strong gale and
squally passing over the river and steering ESE took
in sail to a two reef main close reef fore top sail and
fore course copper sick

Wednesday January 6 1847

Cont. with ~~streaky~~ foggy weather
and a strong gale from WNW steering ESE

Middle part moderate and clearing
Made sail as required under W steering ESE

Continued Jacob L. Cleveland Master
Last part fair but cloudy with fresh
heaves from W steering ESE saw 4 finbacks not
155 many birds ground looks barren copper sick

Thursday January 7 1847

Cont. with fair but cloudy weather
and fresh heaves from W steering ESE

Middle part strong heaves with heavy squalls

Friday January 8 1847

Cont. with fair weather and squalls at
intervals saw finbacks

W steering ESE with squalls at intervals

Longitude from chron 125° 00'E

Saturday January 9 1847

Cont. with cloudy weather and strong
heaves from W steering ESE

Middle part much the same heavy squalls
Last part cloudy with strong heaves
from W steering ESE with strong squalls

Latitude by obs 40° 57' South
Longitude from chron 130° 34'E

Sunday January 10 1847

Cont. with cloudy weather and strong
heaves from W steering ESE

Middle part much the same
Last part fair but cloudy with strong heaves
from W steering ESE saw a spotted sun bird all present
sail but Latitude by obs 40° 17' South Longitude from chron 135° 02'E
