160 Left with fair but cloudy weather and
a strong gale from W. steering E by S.
Middle part moderate breeze
sail as required

Last part fair but cloudy with
high breezes from W. steering E by S saw a fishback
and saw porpoise exchanged the fore top sails
Latitude by obs 44° 40' South
Longitude by chron 157° 0'

Tuesday January 12 1847

161 Left with fair but cloudy weather and
high breezes from W. steering E saw porpoises and a fishback
Middle part fair but cloudy with
Last part cloudy with fresh breezes
from W. steering E saw fishbacks

Latitude by obs 44° 43' S
Longitude by chron 140° 50' E

Wednesday January 13 1847

162 Left with fair but cloudy weather
and high breezes from W. steering E
Middle part much the same
Last part cloudy with strong breezes
from W. steering E saw porpoises

Latitude by obs 45° 13' South
Longitude by chron 144° 12' East

Thursday January 14 1847

163 Left with cloudy weather and strong
breezes from W. steering E by S
Middle part fair but cloudy
weather and high breezes from W.

Last part fair but cloudy weather
and high breezes from W. saw a fishback and a whale that
spouted 4 or 5 times we lost three fathoms for a sperm
whale but have not seen him since

164 Left with fair weather and light
breezes from W. steering E by S
Middle part fair weather and light
breezes from W. steering E by S

Last part fair pleasant weather
and light airs from W. steering E by S the wind to E
began to freshen the boat saw Killers

Latitude by obs 45° 10' South
Longitude by chron 149° 04' E

Saturday January 16 1847

165 Left with fair weather and light breezes
from W. steering E by S the wind to E saw two fishbacks
Middle part cloudy with strong breezes
and squalls. Handed jib and on course two to set
the top sails

Last part cloudy with a moderate gale
from W. steering E by S the wind to E

Latitude by obs 45° 12' South
Longitude by chron 151° 20' E

Sunday January 17 1847

166 Left with squally weather and a
moderate gale from W. steering E by S the
wind at 6 P.M. thick fog set in and on course
Middle part foggy with light breezes
from W. steering E by S

Last part thick fog and
small breezes from W. steering E by S
saw obs no obs

Monday January 18 1847

167 Left with thick fog and small airs
from W. steering E by S
Middle part fair but cloudy with
light breezes

Last part fair with small breezes from
W. steering E by S Handed the boat
Lat 44° 55' Long 153° 01' E
