Sunday March 28 1847

Com^d with cloudy squally weather with squalls at intervals and fresh breezes from E to ESE steering to st
Middle part fair weather and fresh breezes from ESE steering to st
Last part fair with fresh breezes from ESE steering to st all sail set fair squalls
Latitude by obs 4° 27' South
Longitude by Account 154° 40' West

Monday March 29 1847

Com^d with fair weather and fresh breezes from ESE to st by the wind at 2 PM squally with rain thick in the clouds thick fog at 4 PM raining and foggy at 6 PM st E, hauly to E and st E again
Middle part cloudy with rain at intervals and light breezes from E to st took in studds and studds from st E steering to st by the wind
Last part thick and rainy with light breezes from st E steering to st by the wind
No obs

Tuesday March 30 1847

Com^d with fair weather and a calm
Middle part light breezes from st E steering to st by the wind
Last part fair weather and light breezes from st E steering to st by the wind saw lots of porpoises
Latitude by obs 5° 23' South
Longitude for Chron^o 155° 27' West

Wednesday March 31 1847

Com^d with fine weather and small breezes from st E steering to st by the wind at 2 PM calm
Middle part fine weather and light breezes steering to st
Last part fair weather and light breezes from st E steering to st saw some sail pointed the main mast at 10 PM capt John Rogers of Stair having ship Oregon come here reported 700 tubs and 700 sheep and 1 man
Latitude 3° 13' South

Thursday April 1 1847

Com^d with fine weather and light breezes from st E steering to st by the wind the mate of the Oregon and Benjamin Wiley to carry to the Sandwich Islands
Middle part fair with light breezes from ESE steering to st by the wind all drawing sail set
Last part fine weather and light breezes from ESE steering to st all drawing sail set
Latitude by obs 2° 04' South
Longitude for Chron^o 156° 11' West

Friday April 2 1847

Com^d with fair weather and light breezes from ESE steering to st saw grampas, went three boats for sperm whale which did not prove to be whales
Middle part fair weather and light breezes from ESE steering to st with small rains
Last part fair weather and light breezes from ESE steering to st all drawing sail set
Latitude by obs 1° 27' South
Longitude for Chron^o 155° 40' West

Saturday 3 1847

Com^d with fine weather and light breezes from ESE steering to st
Middle and last part fine weather and light breezes from ESE steering to st
Latitude by obs 6 miles with Longitude for Chron^o 155° 50' West

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
