

74. Bogue Cherokee bound to North West from Cork
Continued Last part fine weather with light
breezes from S.E. to S. steering S.W. & sail in
sight pointed the Starboard and waist boats
Latitude by obs 31° 28' North

Sunday May 3 1847
Continued with fine weather and
light breezes from S. steering S.W. at 7 AM sailing
brought some 10 or 12 miles to S.W. & east of us fitted
a new top sail and bent it to the main
Middle part variable breezes from S
with heavy rains and variable breezes

271 Last part fine weather and light
breezes from S. steering to S.W. & sail and the land
at 10 AM saw a school of sperm whales haul three boats
to no purpose haul the Starboard anchor

Monday May 3 1847
Continued with fair but cloudy weather
and brisk breezes from S.W. took up the boat at
2 PM stand S.W. & haul the cables
Middle part fine weather and
brisk breezes from S. & steered S.W.

Last part fine weather and brisk
breezes from S. & steered S.W. & set up rigging and began to
repair the old main top sail
Latitude by obs 32° 50' North
Longitude from Chron 157° 56' West

Tuesday May 4 1847
Continued with fair weather and
brisk breezes from S. & steered S.W. mending old top sail
Middle part cloudy with some rain
and brisk breezes from S. & steering S.W.

272 Last part fair weather and brisk
breezes from S.E. steering S.W. mending the main top sail
all day long sail set
Latitude by obs 32° 30' North
Longitude from Chron 156° 53' West

75. Ship S. Cleveland Master
Wednesday May 5 1847
Continued with fair but heavy weather and
brisk breezes from S. steering to S.W. mending sail
Middle part cloudy with some rain
and brisk breezes

273 Last part fine weather and brisk
breezes from S. & steered S.W. with some small rain-
fall obs
no obs

Thursday May 6 1847
Continued with fair weather and
variable breezes

274 Middle part cloudy with variable breezes
from North steering by the wind each way
Last part cloudy with fine weather and
variable light breezes from S. & heading by the wind each
way middle thickened the main course
Latitude by obs 32° 44' North
Longitude from Chron 155° 58' West

Friday May 7 1847
Continued with cloudy weather and
light breezes from S.W. & steering to S.W. by the wind
Middle part cloudy and squally with

275 fresh breezes from S. & steered S.W. by the wind hauled in
fore top galls and gaff top sail
Last part cloudy with fresh breezes from
S. & hauled in 2 p. galls and fore reef the top sail hauled
heading to S.W. by the wind
Latitude by obs 33° 07' North
Longitude from Chron 157° 24' West

Saturday May 8 1847
Continued with cloudy weather and brisk
breezes from S. & steering to S.W. by the wind made all sail
at 4 PM sold 300 pounds worth goods and chattels

276 Middle part fair weather and light
breezes from S. & steering to S.W. by the wind
