from S. W. saw flocks and a right whale, lowered three
boats and the waist boat struck killed and sunk him
saw a mother at night took in sail and headed to S.
wind E. S. E.

light heers from N. W. heading to N. E.Last part fair weather and light
heers from N. N. W. made sail and steered to hunt
the times saw two sail a humpback and lot of
sulphur bottoms and a right whale lowered three
boats to no purpose look Anthony and Adams off duty still

Saturday June 5 1847

Cont. with cloudy weather and fog
saw a sail and a right whale, lowered three
boats the larboard boat struck killed and sunk
him to the ship at 6 1/2 P. M. took in breast
throat and hips and lashed down stuck in sail
