Saturday June 19 1847

819 Cont^d with cloudy weather and fresh
breezes from S steering to W & W saw fair and humpbacks
and birds took in sail and headed to W & W

Latitude by obs 56° 02' North
Longitude per Chart 149° 46' W
Middle part cloudy with light

breezes from S heading to W & W

Last part cloudy with small breezes
from S headed to S & W made all sail at day light saw
a sail and a carcass and lots of seabirds and some hump
backs took and Adams off duty still

Latitude by obs 56° 07' North
Longitude per Chart 151° 41' West

Sunday June 20 1847

Cont^d with cloudy weather and light breezes
from S heading to S & W saw a carcass a sail and sea
and humpbacks took in top galls at night

820 Middle part fair weather and light
breezes from S & E headed to S & W

Last part fair but cloudy with light
breezes from S & E steering to S & W saw a sail
and lots of humpbacks took and Adams off duty still

Latitude by obs 54° 55' North
Longitude per Chart 151° 41' West

Monday June 21 1847

Cont^d with fair but cloudy weather
and light breezes from S & W steering to S saw lots
of humpbacks and a sail found one but for humpbacks
to no purpose the light part on land the ship

821 Remains beyond of New Bedford 1700 S & W from
6 miles this season

Middle part cloudy with light breezes
from S & W headed to S & W

Last part cloudy with dark breezes
from W & W cruising saw a sail and lots of
humpbacks and some polar whales took & Adams off duty

Cruising Jacob L Cleveland Master

found the boat for Latitude by obs 54° 47' North
Longitude per Chart 152° 00' W
Tuesday June 22 1847

822 Cont^d with fair but cloudy weather
and light breezes from S & W steering to S & W by the
wind saw lots of humpbacks and some polar whales
took in top galls at night

Middle part fair weather and light breezes
from W to S & E heading to S & W

Last part cloudy with light
breezes from S & E steering by the wind each way saw a
sail and lots of hump and seabirds ^{or Delphids} made all sail
Adams off duty still water a pale green and has been
for some time and no whales

Latitude by obs 55° 11' North

Wednesday June 23 1847

Cont^d with cloudy weather and light
breezes from S & E cruising saw humpbacks and a sail spoke
Barge New ten Hale New Bedford 2000 from
New Bedford had taken one night whale and seen one ship
on that coast no whales there had seen plenty of
polar whales on her passage for them took in top galls
at night and headed to S & E

Middle part fair but cloudy with
light breezes from S & E headed to S & E

Last part cloudy with light breezes
from S & E heading to S & W made all sail saw the new ten
saw lots of seabirds some humpbacks and polar whale
water a pale dirty green covered two boats for one polar
whale to no purpose Adams off duty still

Latitude by obs 54° 49' North

Longitude per Chart 152° 30' West

Thursday June 24 1847

Cont^d with fair but cloudy weather
and light breezes from S & E heading to S saw two
polar whales took sail to a two reefed sail & some
humpbacks and took sail at 7 E water a deep green
