Last part cloudy with fog and a
 strong gale from S.W. set the course and let a reef off
 the top sail at 6 1/2 a.m. steered E.N.E. Adams off
 duty still water light blue turning green

 and light breezes from S.S.E. heading to E by the wind

Last part cloudy with fog and light
 breezes from S.S.E. to E.S.E. made all sail saw finbacks

 from N.N.E. made all sail and steered E.S.E.
 took in top gall at 11 hauled down sails in
 courses two reefed the top sails Adams off duty still
 sea part water green last part blue

Monday June 28 1847

Continued with cloudy weather and
 a strong gale with a high sea on at 12 P.M. hauled down
 course and close reefed the top sail hauled to the north

327 Middle part cloudy with some fog
 and a strong gale from W heading to N.N.W. a high sea

Last part a strong gale from W
 with a high sea on heading to N.W. Adams off duty still
 water blue

Tuesday June 29 1847

Continued with a strong gale from W.S.W. and
 a high sea on west to S

Middle part moderate with
 cloudy weather and some fog wind blew to S.S.E.

Last part thick fog with light breezes
 from S.W. steering N made all sail Adams off duty still
 blue water
