 cut let him lay saw a sprat Adams off duty still
 Latitude 54 40 3 North

Friday July 2 1847

Cont. with a strong gale and a sharp sea
 with cloudy weather by by the whole to S E wind S E
 clear away the head

 and strong breezes from S we cut up the whole saw a
 night whale haul two boats to no purpose

 breezes from S we heading to S E reefed at night
 Middle part cloudy with high breezes
 from S we to S E headed by the wind took away
 Last part cloudy with fog and high breezes
 from S we made sail to now stand down in the whole
 side of the fore pole James Christy off duty still green water
 saw a fisher Latitude by obs 54 40 00 North

Wednesday July 7 1847

Cont. with cloudy foggy weather and
 high breezes from S we heading to S E saw a sail and a
 whale spoke ship Bingham scaffold of Mistie 800
 4 whales this season took in sail as usual
 Middle part cloudy with high breezes
 from S we heading to S E
